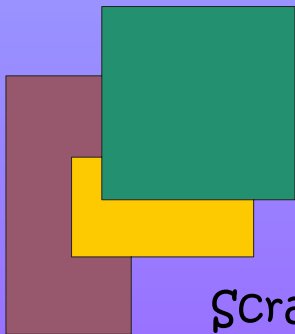
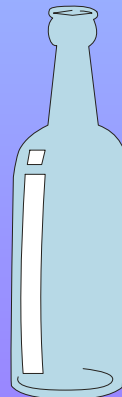


7 Buttons

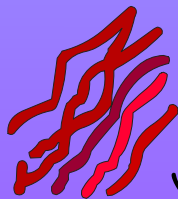


1 3-inch

Beans

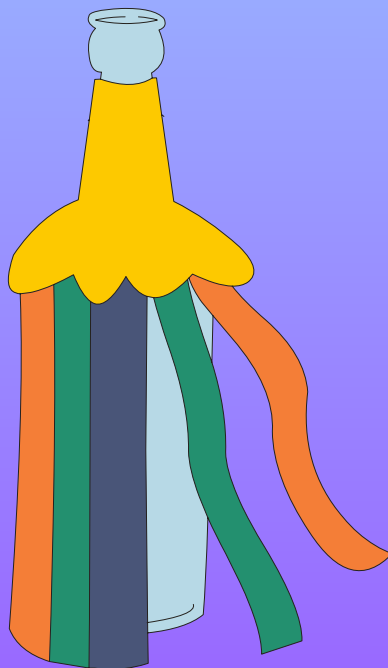

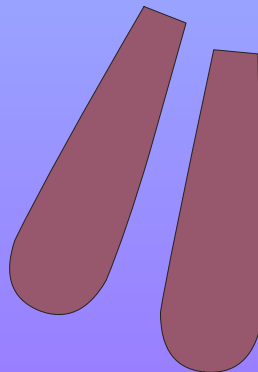
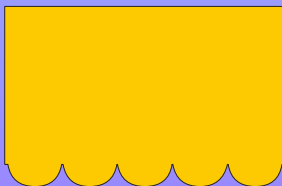
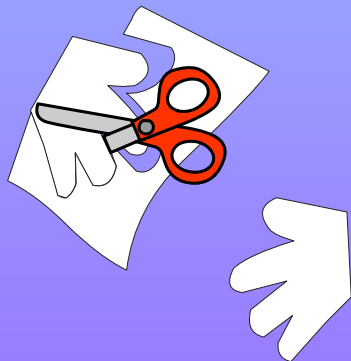
1. Decorate the bottle with pieces of felt like a clown's costume.

2. Cut out from the felt hands, feet and apron.

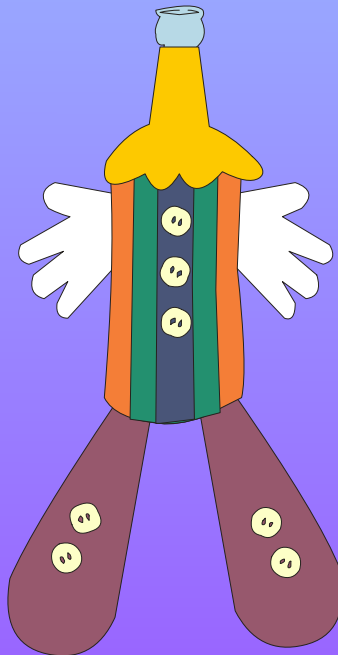

3. Glue them onto the dressed bottle. Glue the buttons onto the clothing.

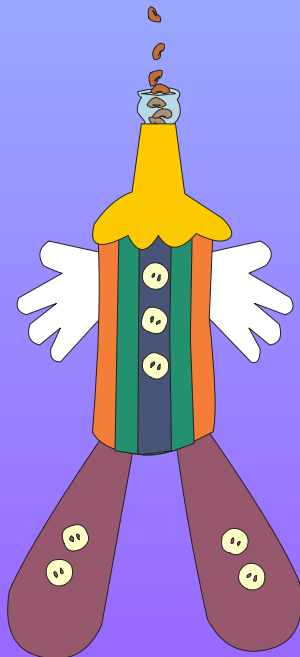

4. Fill up 1/4 of the bottle with beans.

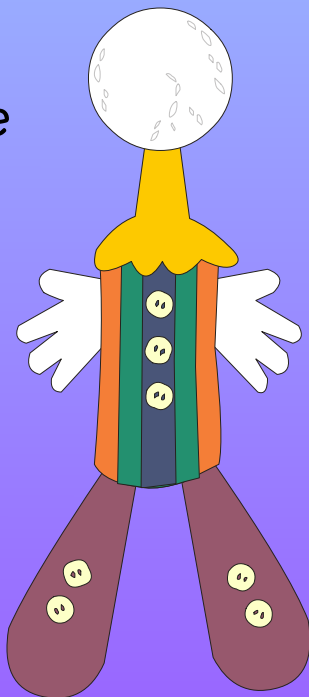




# Gragger

5. Attach the styrofoam ball onto the top of the bottle like a cork (without the cover).

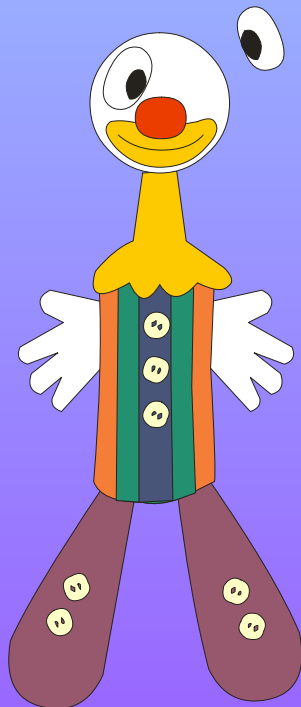

6. Make the clown's face with pieces of felt.

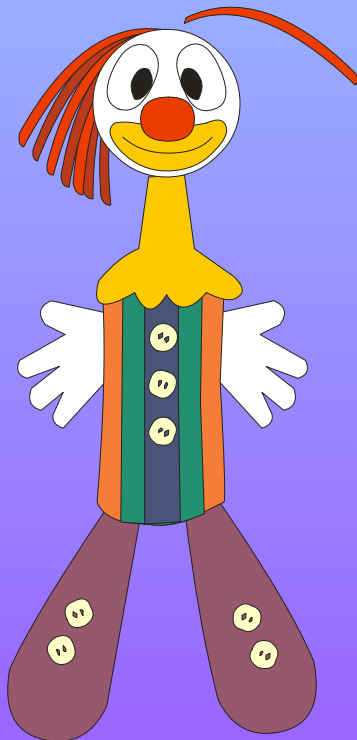




# Gragger
