Lesson Five: Rules Twelve to Thirteen of Torah Elucidation

Methods for elucidating seemingly unclear or paradoxical Torah verses. Principles 12-13 are covered in this final lesson of the series.

Rule 12

Davar halamed m'inyano, v'davar halamed m'sof (דבר ה'למד מעניינו, ודבר ה'למד מסופו) - A subject whose meaning is learned from its context and a subject whose meaning is learned from a subsequent statement

Elucidation of a Passage from Information Given in Nearby or Later Passages

Rule 13

Shnei Kasuvim hamachachishim zeh es zeh ad sheyavo hakasuv hashlishi v'yachria beineihem (שני (כתובים המכחישים זה את זה, עד שיבוא הכתוב השלישי ויכריע ביניהם) - Two contradictory verses whose reconciliation comes about through a third verse
