## What is the meaning of dependent/conditional existence?

There are three levels of expression, referred to as the three levushim – garments:

**Thought** - Is the form of expression to oneself

**Speech** - Is the form of expression to others people

Action - Is the form of expression to the rest of the world

דומר – Torm

צורה – Matter

The matter of any object is its tangible.

The form of an object is how the matter is shaped to serve its particular purpose.



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EPISODE 3: G-D vs. MAN



G-D

Creates from nothingness the matter, which occupies space and possesses mass.

People

Gives form to pre-existing matter, to change its purpose or use.

G-d creates something from nothing; G-d brings matters into existence. Conversely, a person merely reshapes the mass, without making any inherent change or addition to the mass of the matter itself. The difference: G-d creates ex nihilo, something from nothing. A person can only reinvent what already exists.

And Moses stretched out his hand over the sea, and the L-rd led the sea with the strong east wind all night, and He made the sea into dry land and the waters split.

Water, by nature, does not hold solid form. At the splitting of the sea, G-d invested His creative energy to change the essential nature of water. G-d did not transform water into a solid matter; He recreated the nature of the water, so that it would hold the stationary position of a wall--while maintaining its makeup, a liquid without a stationary form.

The energy of the creator [is] constantly in the creation.

כח הפועל בנפעל תמיד

When something is created completely from nothing, ex nihilo, it must always be maintained by its original creative energy. Such a creation is possible only for G-d, the true and necessary existence.
