A Proclamation

Whereas, Education forms the bedrock of our society imbuing the future of our citizenry with the necessary knowledge & skills to materialize their dreams; and

Whereas, The Great Leader of World Jewry the Rebbe, Rabbi Menachem M. Schneerson of righteous memory, taught that this knowledge and skill ought not to be limited to scholastic & occupational success rather it must lend itself to ethical, moral & spiritual fulfilment; and

Whereas, The Rebbe inspired millions across this nation and beyond, young and old, Jewish and Gentile alike, to advance their education in the above cited manner by emphasizing the study of the Seven Noahide Laws and encouraging the reflection upon it in a daily Moment of Silence; and

Whereas, In the year 1978, Education & Sharing Day U.S.A was established by a joint Congressional Resolution to raise educational awareness across this great land coinciding with the Rebbe's birthday; and

Whereas, Even after his passing, the Rebbe's message of a moral education continues to inspire the global population thru the four thousand Chabad Centers including thirty five in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts,

Now, Therefore, I, Charles D. Baker, Governor of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, do hereby proclaim March 27th 2018, to be,
