A PROCLAMATION

EDUCATION AND SHARING DAY

- WHEREAS: Excellent education is instrumental in ensuring the continued growth and success of our state and nation; and
- WHEREAS: The State of Georgia is dedicated to providing all students with access to educational opportunities that promote achievement in the classrooms of today and the workforce of the future; and
- WHEREAS: Education instills within our children critical instruction in the areas of literacy, math, science, and history, as well as invaluable lessons of moral fortitude and upstanding character that are the building blocks of strong communities; and
- WHEREAS: Education and Sharing Day was first recognized by the United States Congress on April 18, 1978, the day of the birth of Rabbi Menachem Schneerson. This observance honors the Rebbe's dedication to the advancement of education for all; and
- WHEREAS: As an educator and a tireless advocate for youth around the world, the Rebbe emphasized the importance of intellect and good character and instilled within people around the world the hope for a brighter future; and
- WHEREAS: This year marks the 40th anniversary of Education and Sharing Day. On March 27, 2018, state and local leaders, educators, volunteers, and citizens across Georgia will help children develop a love of learning and service to others; now
- THEREFORE: I, NATHAN DEAL, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim March 27, 2018, as EDUCATION AND SHARING DAY in Georgia.
