Historical Background: Who's Who? – The World Scene:

BABYLONIAN EMPIRE:

MEDEAN EMPIRE:

Darius—king of Medes. Sent message to Cyrus to make an alliance by Cyrus marrying his daughter.

Daughter of Darius (name unknown)—
married Cyrus. Cyrus
and Darius attacked and killed Balshatzar and overcame Babylonia.
They spared
Balshazar's pretty,
young daughter, Vashti.

Achashverosh—son of Cyrus and Darius's daughter. Inherited from his father and grandfather the kingdoms of Persia, Medea and Babylonia. During his period, the miracle of Purim took place. Married Vashti had her killed and married Esther, Jewish heroine of Purim.

Darius II—son of **Esther** and **Achashverosh** who allowed the Jews to return to Israel and rebuild the Temple.
