## **Get Out of the Ark!**

Letters and Numbers of Torah - Noach

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The word היצא hay-itzei is a "kri-and-a-ksiv," a word that is pronounced (kri) one way, but written (ksiv) in the Torah scroll a different way.

These two ways of reading the word also imply different shades of meaning.

Rashi explains that the *kri* in Genesis 8:17, *ha-yitzei*, implies, "Order them (all the animals) that they should go out." However, the *ksiv* of this word, הוצא ho-tzei, implies, "If they don't want to go out, take them out *by force*."
